How to get Universitas Esa Unggul Jakarta ?



Universitas Esa Unggul (UEU) is located in the heart of West Jakarta and is made up of five buildings, A, B, C, D and E which are each two minutes away from one another. Numerous more colleges, both public and private, as well as busy public areas like sports facilities, commercial and retail centers, hospitals, police stations, markets, and many more are all located close to the campuses.

From Soekarto-Hatta International Airport to Universitas Esa Unggul by Taxi Online

Step 1: Book Your Taxi:

Open your preferred online taxi app (like Gojek, Grab, or others).

Set your pickup location as Soekarno-Hatta Airport and choose Terminal 3.

Enter your destination as Universitas Esa Unggul.

Step 2: Find the Pickup Point:

Follow the app's instructions to locate the designated pickup area in the arrivals section of Terminal 3.

Step 3: Get into the Taxi:

Once your driver arrives, confirm your ride, and get into the taxi

Step 4: Enter Prof. Dr. Ir. Sedyatmo Toll Road:

The driver will enter the Prof. Dr. Ir. Sedyatmo Toll Road, which leads from the airport towards central Jakarta.

Step 5: Merge onto Jakarta Inner Ring Road (Tol Dalam Kota):

After a few kilometers on the airport toll road, the driver will transition onto the Jakarta Inner Ring Road, typically heading towards Tomang.

Step 6: Exit at Kebon Jeruk Toll Gate:

The driver will exit the toll road at the Kebon Jeruk Toll Gate.

Step 7: Drive to Jalan Arjuna Utara:

After exiting, the driver will proceed on Jalan Arjuna Utara.

Step 8: Arrive at Universitas Esa Unggul:

Estimated Travel Time: Approximately 30-45 minutes (depending on traffic conditions).





How to get Universitas Esa Unggul Jakarta ?

From Soekarto-Hatta International Airport to Universitas Esa Unggul by Commuter Line

Step 1: Take the Airport Rail Link

From Soekarno-Hatta Airport, take the Airport Rail Link from Soekarno-Hatta Airport Station to Batu Ceper Station.

Travel time: Around 15–20 minutes.

Departure frequency: Every 30 minutes.

Step 2: Take the KRL from Batu Ceper Station

At Batu Ceper Station, transfer to the KRL Commuter Line (Tangerang Line) heading to Duri Station.

Get off at Pesing Station.

Travel time: Around 15–20 minutes.

Step 3: Continue by Car from Pesing Station

After arriving at Pesing Station, you can continue by car (taxi or online ride service) to Universitas Esa Unggul in Kebon Jeruk, West Jakarta.

Estimated time: Around 10–15 minutes (depending on traffic).

Distance: Approximately 3–4 kilometers.

Driving Route from Pesing Station:

From Pesing Station, take Jalan Daan Mogot towards Jalan Arjuna Utara.

Follow the road until you reach Universitas Esa Unggul.

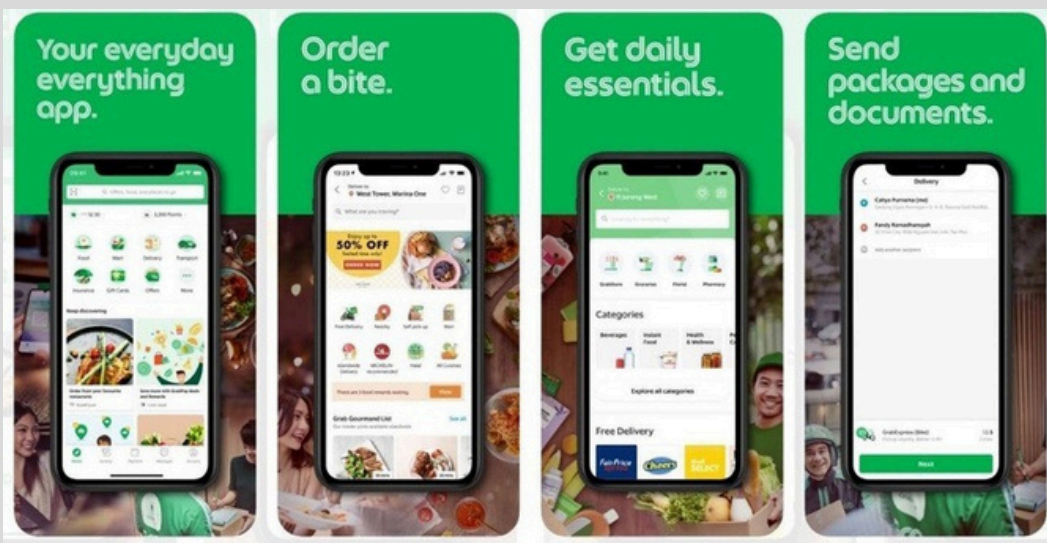
What is Gojek and Grab ?

Gojek



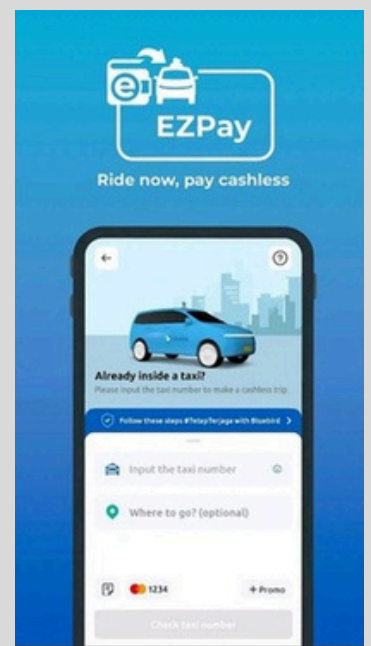
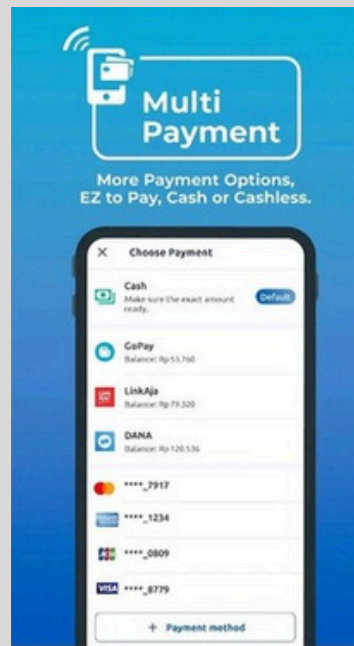
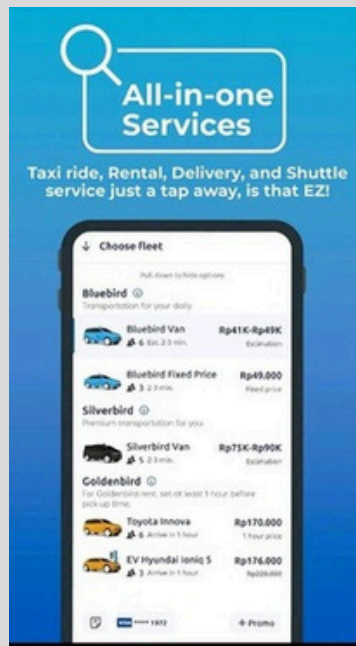
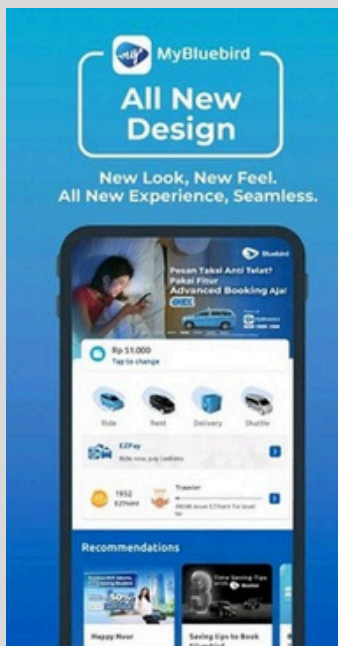

What is Fatahillah Museum and what inside in there?

Museum Fatahillah, also known as Museum Sejarah Jakarta, is a historical museum located in Jakarta, Indonesia. It is situated in the heart of the Old City, Jalan Taman Fatahillah No. 1, Jakarta Barat. The museum is housed in a historic building that was once the City Hall of Batavia, built in 1707-1710 during the Dutch colonial era.



The museum has a rich collection of artifacts and exhibits that showcase the history of Jakarta, including:

- **Replica of the Tugu Inscription:** A replica of the inscription on the Tugu monument, which provides information about the Tarumanegara kingdom.
- **Replica of the Padrão of Sunda Kelapa:** A replica of the Padrão monument, which marks the existence of the Sunda Kelapa harbor.
- **Betawi Furniture:** Antique furniture from the 17th to 19th centuries.
- **Prehistoric Artifacts:** Ancient artifacts such as prasasti and swords.

- **Ceramics:** Antique ceramics.

- **Unfinished Mural by Harijadi Sumodidjojo:** An unfinished mural by the artist Harijadi Sumodidjojo.



The museum also features a prison cell in the basement, which was used to imprison people who resisted Dutch colonial rule. The museum's collection is arranged chronologically, showcasing Jakarta's history from prehistoric times to the present day. It includes artifacts related to the city's early history, the colonial era, and the struggle for independence.

What is Istiqlal Mosque?



Istiqlal Mosque is the largest mosque in Southeast Asia, located in Jakarta, Indonesia. It is a symbol of religious tolerance and a manifestation of gratitude to Allah for Indonesia's independence. The mosque was constructed to conform to President Sukarno's vision of a strong, multi-faith state with the government at its center. It stands across the street from the Catholic Jakarta Cathedral and next to Merdeka Square, home to the Independence Monument.

What is Cathedral?

The Jakarta Cathedral, officially known as Gereja Santa Maria Diangkat ke Surga, is a Roman Catholic cathedral located in Central Jakarta, Indonesia. It is the seat of the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Jakarta and was consecrated in 1901. The cathedral is built in the neo-Gothic style, a common architectural style for churches during that time.



Why Cathedral and Istiqlal Mosque across each other?

The Jakarta Cathedral and the Istiqlal Mosque are situated across from each other in Merdeka Square, Jakarta, Indonesia. This proximity is not a coincidence but rather a deliberate choice made by Indonesia's first president, Sukarno, to symbolize the nation's philosophy of unity in diversity. Sukarno envisioned a strong, multi-faith state with the government at its center, where all religions could coexist peacefully.

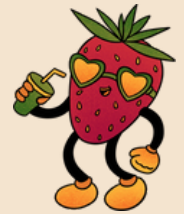
Museum Macan

Money Changer



Within the airport area money changer facilities are available. This place can be found in Terminal 2 and Terminal 3. Some of the money changers available include: - BRI Bank money changer - Money changer Bank Mandiri - BCA Bank money changer - Money changer Bank BNI - Money changer Eraska Valutama - Money changer Indocev - Money changer Valasindo

Requirements for Exchanging Money at a Money Changer

Quoted from the BTN, BNI 46, and Mandiri websites, the requirements needed to exchange money are:

- ID CARD
- Performed in cash, unless you are allowed to use giro/valas
- Using the latest exchange rate
- The maximum amount of exchange according to the rules of the relevant money changer. BTN sets a maximum amount of US\$100,000 equivalent for customers, and US\$10,000 equivalent for non-customers.

How to Exchange Money at Money Changer?

The procedure for exchanging money through a money changer is: 1. Before exchanging money, make sure you update the latest exchange rate information. Information about the exchange rate can be seen on the bank's website, mobile application, or ask the money changer officer. 2. Visit the nearest and trusted money changer with identity card and money to be exchanged. 3. Give the money to be exchanged to the money changer officer. 4. After the exchange process is complete, the officer will give the money that has been exchanged according to the nominal requested.

You can also visit the nearby Puri Indah Mall to exchange your money. The money changer is called Tri Tunggal Money Changer.

Where do we buy sim card?



Telkomsel presents Tourist Prepaid Card, a starter pack designed specifically for foreign tourists visiting Indonesia. This card can be ordered through Telkomsel's official website from the tourist's home country and taken when the tourist arrives in Indonesia. Tourist Prepaid Card is only available for purchase by validation requirements using passport and cell phone IMEI number. SIM card registration, especially prepaid cards by foreigners, can be done at the operator's customer service outlets based on passport data or Permanent Residence Permit Card (KITAP) or Temporary Residence Permit Card (KITAS).

Before you buy a SIM card, make sure to prepare several things, including:

- Make sure your phone is not locked to a specific network. Include a passport photo, as well as a screenshot of the IMEI information by dialing or calling *#06#. Please note, with this purchase you will get
- 25 GB of data quota valid for 30 days. It is important to note that the purchase of a Tourist Prepaid Card is non-refundable under any
- circumstances and for any reason.

In addition, there are some important things that also need to be considered, such as: The maximum number of SIM cards that can be registered using 1 passport (maximum 3 SIM cards). Maximum time limit for SIM Card collection (14 days from pre-booking). Prepare the necessary documents when collecting the Tourist Prepaid Card including confirmation email, passport, and cell phone IMEI.
